A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE DEDICATION OF ADDITIONAL GENERAL FUND MONEY**
102 **TO FUND TRANSPORTATION NEEDS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law, enacted in Senate Bill 18-001, requires the state treasurer to transfer, on July 1, 2019, a total amount of \$150 million from the general fund to fund transportation needs as follows:

- ! \$105 million (70%) to the state highway fund;
- ! \$22.5 million (15%) to the highway users tax fund for allocation in equal shares to counties and municipalities;

- ! \$22.5 million (15%) to the multimodal transportation options fund.

The bill increases the total amount of the July 1, 2019, transfer to \$340 million so that the amount of the individual transfer to the multimodal transportation options fund is unchanged and the individual transfers to the state highway fund and the highway users tax fund are increased to the following amounts:

- ! \$266.5 million (78.38%) to the state highway fund;
- ! \$51 million (15%) to the highway users tax fund for allocation in equal shares to counties and municipalities; and
- ! \$22.5 million (6.62%) to the multimodal transportation options fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-219, **amend**
3 (5)(b) as follows:

4 **24-75-219. Transfers - transportation - capital construction -**
5 **definitions - repeal.** (5) (b) On July 1, 2019, the state treasurer shall
6 transfer a total amount of ~~one~~ THREE hundred fifty FORTY million dollars
7 from the general fund for the purposes of funding state and local
8 transportation needs as follows:

9 (I) ~~One hundred five~~ TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX million FIVE
10 HUNDRED THOUSAND dollars to the state highway fund;

11 (II) ~~Twenty-two~~ FIFTY-ONE million ~~five hundred thousand~~ dollars
12 to the highway users tax fund for allocation to counties and municipalities
13 as specified in section 43-4-205 (6.4); and

14 (III) Twenty-two million five hundred thousand dollars to the
15 multimodal transportation options fund.

16 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
