A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT CONSENT OF THE OWNER OF REAL**
102 **PROPERTY BE OBTAINED BEFORE THE PROPERTY MAY BE LISTED**
103 **ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES.**

Bill Summary

Prior to taking any action to approve a national property documentation form (form) or to request the approval of the keeper of the national register of an executed form, the bill requires the state historical society to require the applicant to obtain the consent, evidenced by a notarized signature, of each owner of the land and property described in

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 24-80.1-108.5
3 as follows:

4 **24-80.1-108.5. Owner consent for inclusion of land and**
5 **property in multiple property documentation form.**

6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, PRIOR TO TAKING ANY
7 ACTION TO APPROVE A MULTIPLE PROPERTY DOCUMENTATION FORM OR TO
8 REQUEST THE APPROVAL OF THE KEEPER OF THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF
9 AN EXECUTED MULTIPLE PROPERTY DOCUMENTATION FORM, THE SOCIETY
10 SHALL REQUIRE THE APPLICANT TO OBTAIN THE CONSENT, EVIDENCED BY
11 A NOTARIZED SIGNATURE, OF EACH OWNER OF THE LAND AND PROPERTY
12 INCLUDED WITHIN THE REGION OF LANDS DESCRIBED IN THE FORM WHO
13 PROVIDED ANY INFORMATION OR GRANTED ACCESS TO THEIR LAND OR
14 PROPERTY.

15 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
16 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
17 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
18 general assembly (August 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3,
19 2019); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
20 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
21 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
22 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
23 to be held in November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the
24 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

1 (2) This act applies to applications for approval of a multiple
2 property documentation form submitted on or after the applicable
3 effective date of this act.
