**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING A TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE STATE EMPLOYEE**  
102      **RESERVE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.**

**Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$10 million from the state employee reserve fund (fund) to the general fund on July 1, 2019. Specifically, the transfer is of money that is in the account dedicated to the department of corrections within the fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-50-104, **add**  
3 (1)(j)(III)(C) as follows:

4           **24-50-104. Job evaluation and compensation - state employee**  
5 **reserve fund - created - definitions - repeal. (1) Total compensation**  
6 **philosophy. (j) (III) (C) ON JULY 1, 2019, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL**  
7 **TRANSFER TEN MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE ACCOUNT DEDICATED TO THE**  
8 **DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS WITHIN THE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.**

9           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
