**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING TRANSFERS FROM THE MARIJUANA CASH FUND TO THE**  
102 **MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND.**

**Bill Summary**

*(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. **Joint Budget Committee.** The bill requires the state treasurer to make 2 transfers from the marijuana cash fund to the marijuana tax cash fund. On July 1, 2019, the state treasurer will transfer \$914,416, and on July 1, 2020, the state treasurer will transfer \$890,901.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-11-501, **add**  
3 (1)(d)(III) as follows:

4 **44-11-501. Marijuana cash fund.** (1) (d) (III) ON JULY 1, 2019,  
5 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER NINE HUNDRED FOURTEEN  
6 THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTEEN DOLLARS FROM THE MARIJUANA CASH  
7 FUND TO THE MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
8 39-28.8-501. ON JULY 1, 2020, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER  
9 EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED ONE DOLLARS FROM  
10 THE MARIJUANA CASH FUND TO THE MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND.

11 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-801, **add as**  
12 **relocated by Senate Bill 19-224** (1)(d)(III) as follows:

13 **44-10-801. Marijuana cash fund.** (1) (d) (III) ON JULY 1, 2019,  
14 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER NINE HUNDRED FOURTEEN  
15 THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTEEN DOLLARS FROM THE MARIJUANA CASH  
16 FUND TO THE MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
17 39-28.8-501. ON JULY 1, 2020, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER  
18 EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED ONE DOLLARS FROM  
19 THE MARIJUANA CASH FUND TO THE MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND.

20 **SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2019;  
21 except that section 2 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 19-224  
22 becomes law, in which case section 2 takes effect January 1, 2020.

23 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
