CLARIFY DISCLOSURE OF A REPORT TO AT-RISK ADULT **Bill Topic:**

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill clarifies that only at-risk adults who are the subject of a **Fiscal Impact:** report of mistreatment or self-neglect may have access to the report. The bill has no

fiscal impact on any state or local revenue or expenditures.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

This bill clarifies that only the at-risk adults who is the subject of a report of mistreatment or self-neglect, or his or her guardian or guardian ad litem if incapacitated, may have access to the report.

Background

House Bill 19-1063 allows at-risk adults to have access to information relating to the investigation of mistreatment or neglect of the at-risk adult once the investigation is complete. The information cannot include any identifying information related to the reporting party. The bill was signed into law on March 21, 2019, and will take effect on August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill clarifies that the only at-risk adult who is the subject of a report may have access of the report. Clarifying who may have access to the report will not affect state and local revenue or expenditures; therefore this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
