This bill modernizes laws authorizing health care cooperatives to incorporate consumer protections and collective rate negotiations. This bill may increase state workload beginning in FY 2019-20.

Summary of Legislation

This bill modernizes laws authorizing health care cooperatives in the state to incorporate consumer protections and collective rate negotiations.

State Expenditures

Beginning in FY 2019-20, the Division of Insurance (DOI) in the Department of Regulatory Agencies will have a potential workload increase related to health care cooperatives to the extent that the modernization of the health care cooperative statutes encourages their use. No change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 17, 2019.
