CONCERNING A MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITION OF "STATE AGENCY" FOR PURPOSES OF THE STATEWIDE INTERNET PORTAL AUTHORITY TO ENSURE THAT THE AUTHORITY IS AUTHORIZED TO SERVE ALL STATE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-37.7-101, **amend** the introductory portion and (6) as follows:

- **24-37.7-101. Definitions.** As used in this article ARTICLE 37.7, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (6) "State agency" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 24-37.5-102 (4) MEANS EVERY INSTRUMENTALITY OF STATE GOVERNMENT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, AND ALL OF THEIR RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS, COMMISSIONS,

BOARDS, AUTHORITIES, BUREAUS, AND OFFICES.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
