The House Rural Affairs and Agriculture Committee Report (02/24/20) and the House Finance Committee Report (05/28/20) include amendments to the bill and Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the committee amendments do not change the fiscal impact of the bill.

The Fiscal Note (02/21/20) specifies bill will have a TABOR Refund impact of \$37,500, however subsequent economic forecasts indicate no TABOR Refund potential for FY 2020-21 and thus this impact is no longer likely.
