**Bill Topic:** CONSENT TO SHELTER AND SERVICES BY HOMELESS YOUTH

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** This bill allows homeless youth who are 14 years of age or older to consent to receiving shelter services from a licensed homeless youth shelter without parental consent or notification. The bill has no impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill allows homeless youth, ages 14 and up, to consent to receive shelter or shelter services from a licensed homeless youth shelter. With such consent received from the youth, the homeless youth shelter is not required to notify the youth's parent or legal guardian or to seek additional parental consent.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill requires no program changes or affirmative actions to be taken by state or local government agencies. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
