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Bill Topic: DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT HEALTH FACILITY LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill repeals obsolete provisions for health facilities licenses issued by the Department of Public Health and Environment. The bill has no impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes the requirement for health facility licenses issued by the Department of Public Health and Environment to include the signature of the president of the State Board of Health, the attestation of the board secretary, and the state board's seal.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Removing obsolete language for health facility licensing has no affect on operations in the Department of Public Health and Environment. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 11, 2020, and takes effect September 14, 2020, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
