Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies in its sunset review and report on the "Laura Hershey Disability Support Act" by continuing the act for 5 years. This continues the Colorado disability funding committee, which auctions motor vehicle license plate numbers to raise money to aid persons with disabilities in accessing disability benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 24-30-2212
3 as follows:

4 **24-30-2212. Sunset review - repeal of part.** ~~(1)~~ This part 22 is
5 repealed, effective September 1, ~~2021~~ 2026.

6 ~~(2) Prior to such repeal, the department of regulatory agencies~~
7 ~~shall review the assistance program for disability benefits as provided for~~
8 ~~in section 24-34-104~~ BEFORE THE REPEAL, THIS PART 22 IS SCHEDULED
9 FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-34-104.

10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**
11 (21)(a)(I); and **add** (27)(a)(XVIII) as follows:

12 **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**
13 **and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative**
14 **declaration - repeal.** (21) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,
15 will repeal on September 1, 2021:
