101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION FOR REMOTE PARTICIPATION IN**  
102 **POLITICAL PARTY COMMITTEE MEETINGS.**

**Bill Summary**

Through the end of 2021, the bill allows members of a party central committee or vacancy committee to participate in a committee meeting remotely, including by casting the member's vote by e-mail, mail, telephone, or through an internet-based application if allowed by the party's rules.

executive committee to adopt party rules or bylaws to implement the bill's remote participation provisions. The bill also permits a member of the state party central committee or state party executive committee considering such rules or bylaws to participate remotely in a meeting in which the rules or bylaws are being considered.

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-3-103, **add** (11) as  
3 follows:

4           **1-3-103. Party committees - repeal.** (11) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING  
5 ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, A MEMBER OF A CENTRAL COMMITTEE  
6 MAY PARTICIPATE IN A CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING, INCLUDING A  
7 MEETING REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, REMOTELY, INCLUDING CASTING THE  
8 MEMBER'S VOTE BY E-MAIL, MAIL, TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH AN  
9 INTERNET-BASED APPLICATION IF ALLOWED BY THE PARTY'S RULES.

10           (b) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, A  
11 STATE PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE OR STATE PARTY EXECUTIVE  
12 COMMITTEE MAY ADOPT PARTY RULES OR BYLAWS TO IMPLEMENT  
13 SUBSECTION (11)(a) OF THIS SECTION. THE STATE PARTY CENTRAL  
14 COMMITTEE OR STATE PARTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MAY ADOPT SUCH  
15 PARTY RULES OR BYLAWS WITHOUT REGARD FOR ANY NOTICE OR CALL  
16 REQUIREMENTS IN EXISTING PARTY RULES OR BYLAWS. A MEMBER OF THE  
17 STATE PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE OR STATE PARTY EXECUTIVE  
18 COMMITTEE CONSIDERING SUCH RULES OR BYLAWS MAY PARTICIPATE  
19 REMOTELY IN A MEETING IN WHICH THE RULES OR BYLAWS ARE BEING  
20 CONSIDERED, INCLUDING CASTING THE MEMBER'S VOTE BY E-MAIL, MAIL,  
21 TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH AN INTERNET-BASED APPLICATION.

5 CONTRARY, A MEMBER OF A VACANCY COMMITTEE FILLING A VACANCY  
6 PURSUANT TO THIS PART 10 MAY PARTICIPATE IN A VACANCY COMMITTEE  
7 MEETING REMOTELY, INCLUDING CASTING THE MEMBER'S VOTE BY E-MAIL,  
8 MAIL, TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH AN INTERNET-BASED APPLICATION IF  
9 ALLOWED BY THE PARTY'S RULES.

10           (2) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2021.

11           **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-12-203, **add** (6) as  
12 follows:

13           **1-12-203. Vacancies in general assembly - repeal.**  
14 (6)(a) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, A MEMBER  
15 OF A VACANCY COMMITTEE FILLING A VACANCY PURSUANT TO THIS  
16 SECTION MAY PARTICIPATE IN A VACANCY COMMITTEE MEETING  
17 REMOTELY, INCLUDING CASTING THE MEMBER'S VOTE BY E-MAIL, MAIL,  
18 TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH AN INTERNET-BASED APPLICATION IF ALLOWED  
19 BY THE PARTY'S RULES.

20           (b) THIS SUBSECTION (6) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31,  
21 2021.

22           **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-12-206, **add** (7) as  
23 follows:

24           **1-12-206. Vacancies in the office of county commissioner -**  
25 **repeal.** (7) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, A  
26 MEMBER OF A VACANCY COMMITTEE FILLING A VACANCY PURSUANT TO  
27 THIS SECTION MAY PARTICIPATE IN A VACANCY COMMITTEE MEETING

1 REMOTELY, INCLUDING CASTING THE MEMBER'S VOTE BY E-MAIL, MAIL,  
2 TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH AN INTERNET-BASED APPLICATION IF ALLOWED  
3 BY THE PARTY'S RULES.

4 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (7) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31,  
5 2021.

6 **SECTION 5. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
7 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
