A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING FUNDING FOR THE SAFE REVITALIZATION OF**
102 **COLORADO'S MAIN STREETS.**

Bill Summary

The bill transfers \$30 million from the general fund to the state highway fund to provide additional funding for the department of transportation's revitalizing main streets and safer main streets programs.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-219, **add** (6)
2 as follows:

3 **24-75-219. Transfers - transportation - capital construction -**
4 **definitions - repeal.** (6) ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION
5 (6), THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THIRTY MILLION DOLLARS
6 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE PURPOSE
7 OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE REVITALIZING MAIN STREETS
8 AND SAFER MAIN STREETS PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
9 TRANSPORTATION.

10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
