This bill would have allowed counties to use county general fund money for road and bridge projects without declaration of a disaster emergency. The bill may have impacted local government expenditures on an ongoing basis.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation would have been required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, counties may not transfer money from their general fund to their county road and bridge fund unless the county is under a declared disaster emergency. This bill removes this restriction and allows a county to transfer general fund money to a road and bridge fund at any time.

Local Government

If county governments transfer their general funds into road and bridge funds, this will increase funding for transportation and reduce funding available for other general government purposes.

Effective Date

This bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Transportation and Local Government Committee on March 16, 2021.
