This bill removes a requirement that the Office of Legislative Legal Services report rules adopted as a result of legislation to the cosponsor of the bill, and limits the notification period to 8 years. Beginning in FY 2021-22, it will minimally decrease workload on an ongoing basis.

Summary of Legislation

Current law requires that the Office of Legislative Legal Services (OLLS) notify prime sponsors, cosponsors, and committees of reference of rules adopted as a result of their legislation. This bill removes the requirement to notify cosponsors, and limits the notification period of up to eight years after the legislation was enacted.

State Expenditures

The bill removes a reporting requirement for the OLLS in the Legislative Department beginning in FY 2021-22. This may result in a minimal decrease in workload; however, no change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 15, 2021, and takes effect September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
