Summary of Legislation

The bill makes nonsubstantive changes to the Colorado Marijuana Code, including correcting federal citations and removing expired language.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
