The bill requires the Governor to consider diversity when making appointments. It minimally increases state workload on an ongoing basis.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires the Governor to consider geographic and demographic diversity when making appointments to certain boards, commissions, committees, or task forces beginning January 1, 2022.

State Expenditures

The Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions may have increased workload for conducting outreach. This increase is expected to be minimal and no change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 24, 2021, and takes effect on September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
