The House Finance Committee Report (05/22/21) includes amendments to the bill. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the amendments may require adjustments to the amount of Marijuana Tax Cash Fund that will need to be transferred to the Victim Compensation and Victim Assistance Funds. In addition, it is anticipated that the amendments will result in a change in revenue related to prosecution and cost of care. The fiscal impacts of the amendments will be reflected in a newly revised fiscal note to be prepared subsequent to the Appropriations Committee meeting.

### **Points to Consider**

Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$20.4 million available for appropriation or transfer from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, based on that revenue forecast. This bill requires a transfer of \$598,000 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, reducing the anticipated balance by the same amount.
