Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$1,000,000 cash funds from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund to the Department of Higher Education; \$460,227 total funds to the Department of Public Health and Environment, including \$173,250 General Fund and \$286,977 cash funds from the Medical Marijuana Program Cash Fund; and \$255,167 cash funds from the Marijuana Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue; and reappropriating \$95,706 to the Department of Law. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department

of Public Health and Environment will require an additional 3.4 FTE, the Department of Revenue will require an additional 1.5 FTE, and the Department of Law will require an additional 0.5 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$48.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$173,250 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$48.0 million set aside by the same amount.

Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$20.4 million available for appropriation or transfer from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, based on that revenue forecast. This bill requires an appropriation of \$1,000,000 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, reducing the anticipated balance by the same amount.
