**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$511,210 cash funds from the Liquor Enforcement Division and State Licensing Authority Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 6.2 FTE. Of this amount, \$10,634 and an additional 0.1 FTE is reappropriated to the Department of Law and \$35,370 is reappropriated to the Department of Personnel for FY 2021-22.
