Summary of Fiscal Impact:	No fiscal impact. The bill requires that the Governor prioritize selecting electors of Gilpin or Teller County to serve on the Limited Gaming Control Commission. It has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Summary of Legislation

When considering appointments to the Limited Gaming Control Commission, the bill requires that the Governor prioritize appointing members who are registered electors of Gilpin County or Teller County. These members may live in the county, own private residential property, and work in certain industries that are represented on the commission.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Specifying the eligibility and selection criteria for the composition of the Limited Gaming Control Commission in the Department of Revenue does not change the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 21, 2021, and takes effect September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
