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Revised Fiscal Note

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Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill requires that the Governor prioritize selecting electors of Gilpin or Teller County to serve on the Limited Gaming Control Commission. It has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the reengrossed bill, as amended by the House Transportation

and Local Government Committee.

Summary of Legislation

When considering appointments to the Limited Gaming Control Commission, the bill requires that the Governor prioritize appointing members who are registered electors of Gilpin County or Teller County. These members may live in the county, own private residential property, and work in certain industries that are represented on the commission.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Specifying the eligibility and selection criteria for the composition of the Limited Gaming Control Commission in the Department of Revenue does not change the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
