**Bill Topic:**                    **HOUSING MENTORS IN YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FACILITY**

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:**            **No fiscal impact.** The bill allows the Department of Corrections to house mentors in a youthful offender facility if certain conditions are met. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:**            No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:**                    The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill allows the Department of Corrections (DOC) to house an offender involved in a mentorship program with youthful offenders to be housed in a youthful offender facility when certain conditions are met and so long as the offender has not been convicted of a sex offense.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill allows the DOC to move certain offender populations from one DOC facility to another. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 6, 2021, and it takes effect September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
