**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE STATE RECOVERY AUDIT PROGRAM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-30-203.5, **add** (10) as follows:

**24-30-203.5. Recovery audits - legislative declaration - contracting - reporting - definitions - repeal.** (10) ~~THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022.~~

**SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2021 long bill.** To implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual general appropriation act for the 2021-22 state fiscal year to the department of personnel for use by financial operations and reporting for personal services is decreased by \$64,714, and the related FTE is decreased by 1.0 FTE.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
