Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

The bill creates the Pikes Peak international hill climb special license plate. In addition to the standard motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing services cash fund.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-3-261 as

15	THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE, BUT THE DESIGN MUST CONFORM TO
16	STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND BE APPROVED BY THE
17	DEPARTMENT.
18	(3) A PERSON MAY APPLY FOR A PIKES PEAK INTERNATIONAL HILL
19	CLIMB SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE IF THE PERSON PAYS THE TAXES AND FEES
20	REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
21	(4) THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES AND FEES FOR SPECIAL LICENSE
22	PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION IS THE SAME AS THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES
23	AND FEES FOR REGULAR MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES; EXCEPT THAT
24	THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLECT AN ADDITIONAL ONE-TIME FEE OF

1 FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE 2 HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-201.

3 (5) AN APPLICANT MAY APPLY FOR PERSONALIZED PIKES PEAK 4 INTERNATIONAL HILL CLIMB LICENSE PLATES. UPON PAYMENT OF THE 5 ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211 (6)(a) FOR 6 PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE THE PLATES IF THE APPLICANT COMPLIES WITH SECTION 42-3-211. IF AN APPLICANT 7 8 HAS EXISTING PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE, THE 9 APPLICANT MAY TRANSFER THE COMBINATION OF LETTERS OR NUMBERS 10 TO A NEW SET OF PIKES PEAK INTERNATIONAL HILL CLIMB LICENSE PLATES 11 FOR THE VEHICLE UPON PAYING THE FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211 12 (6)(a) AND UPON TURNING IN THE EXISTING PLATES TO THE DEPARTMENT. 13 A PERSON WHO HAS OBTAINED PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES UNDER 14 THIS SUBSECTION (5) MUST PAY THE ANNUAL FEE IMPOSED BY SECTION 15 42-3-211 (6)(b) TO RENEW THE PERSONALIZED PLATES. THE FEES UNDER 16 THIS SUBSECTION (5) ARE IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER APPLICABLE TAXES 17 AND FEES.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 42-3-312 as follows:

42-3-312. Special license plate surcharge. In addition to any other fee imposed by this article 3, an applicant for a special license plate created by rule in accordance with section 42-3-207, as the section existed when the plate was created, or special license plates issued pursuant to sections 42-3-211 to 42-3-214, sections 42-3-217 to 42-3-218, sections 42-3-221 to 42-3-234, sections 42-3-237 to 42-3-258, and section 42-3-260 SECTIONS 42-3-260 AND 42-3-261 shall pay an issuance fee of twenty-five dollars; except that the fee is not imposed on special license

1	plates exempted from additional fees for the issuance of a military special
2	license plate by section 42-3-213 (1)(b)(II). The department shall transfer
3	the fee to the state treasurer, who shall credit it to the licensing services
4	cash fund created in section 42-2-114.5.
5	SECTION 3. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
6	year, \$41,734 is appropriated to the department of revenue for use by the
7	division of motor vehicles. This appropriation consists of \$14,838 from
8	the general fund and \$26,896 from the license plate cash fund created in
9	section 42-3-301(1)(b), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may
10	use this appropriation as follows:
11	(a) \$14,838 from the general fund, for DRIVES maintenance and
12	support; and
13	(b) \$26,896 from the license plate cash fund for use by vehicle
14	services for license plate ordering.
15	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
16	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
