**Bill Topic:** SUNSET HEALTH-CARE WORK FORCE DATA ADVISORY GROUP

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **Sunset bill - No fiscal impact.** The bill repeals the Healthcare Workforce Data Advisory Group. It does not impact state or local revenue or expenditures and has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill sunsets the Healthcare Workforce Data Advisory Group, which is scheduled to repeal September 1, 2022.

## Background

The advisory group was established in 2012 to provide recommendations regarding healthcare professional licensure data. The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Sunset Report determined that the advisory group has achieved its statutory purpose and has not met in several years, and recommends allowing it to repeal in statute. ## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The advisory group will repeal in FY 2022-23 whether or not this bill passes. This bill makes conforming changes in statute based on the upcoming repeal, which will not impact state or local government revenue or expenditures. As a result, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
