Summary of Legislation

The bill updates and clarifies the statutes governing mental health professionals, including eliminating inconsistencies and obsolete language.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

By updating statutory language for consistency and eliminating obsolete provisions, the bill codifies current practice. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 20, 2022, and takes effect on August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
