Summary of Legislation

The bill removes the requirement that an individual in the role of a deputy sheriff, marshal, police officer, or other peace officer be a Colorado resident.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill removes the residency requirement to be a local peace officer, which does not impact state or local revenue or expenditures. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 26, 2022, and takes effect on August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
