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Bill Topic:	NONSUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO RULE REVIEW STATUTES
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Summary	No fiscal impact. This bill makes nonsubstantive changes to rule review statutes.
Fiscal Impact:	The bill will not affect state or local government revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.
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Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill, which was recommended by the Committee on Legal Services.
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Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals obsolete and redundant provisions in the State Administrative Procedure Act, and conforms language to reflect current drafting practices including the use of gender neutral language.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Making nonsubstantive changes to rule review statutes does not affect the revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government; therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 17, 2022, and takes effect on August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
