Bill Topic: NONSUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO TITLE 43

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill makes nonsubstantive changes to Title 43 of state statute. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

The bill makes several corrections and clarifications to Title 43 of state statute.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
