Bill Topic: **MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS**

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill clarifies that motor vehicle dealers may conduct certain activities away from their principal place of business. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill clarifies that motor vehicle dealers may deliver vehicles for test drives, deliver documents for signature, deliver or obtain documents, and deliver motor vehicles to customers at locations away from the dealer's principal place of business.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill clarifies that certain customer services performed by motor vehicle dealers may be conducted away from their principal place of business. The bill clarifies existing statute and does not substantively change procedures or processes in the Department of Revenue. It will not affect state or local revenue or expenditures; therefore, this bill has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 7, 2022, and it took effect on August 9, 2022.
