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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS TO OPERATE A MOTORBOAT IN THIS**  
102 **STATE.**

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**Bill Summary**

Current law requires an operator of a motorboat in the state to be at least 16 years of age but allows an individual who is at least 14 years of age and who has completed a motorboat safety course to operate a motorboat in the state.

The bill prohibits an individual under 16 years of age from operating a motorboat and requires any individual born after January 1,

1984, to take a boating safety course and have a certificate of completion from that course in the individual's possession in order to operate a motorboat.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 33-13-107.1  
3 as follows:

4 **33-13-107.1. Minimum age of motorboat operators - penalty.**

5 (1) No person under ~~sixteen~~ FOURTEEN years of age SHALL OPERATE A  
6 MOTORBOAT IN THIS STATE. AN INDIVIDUAL BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY  
7 1, 1984,     shall NOT operate a motorboat in this state except as provided  
8 in this section.

9 (2) ~~A person fourteen years of age or older who has not reached~~  
10 ~~his or her sixteenth birthday~~ AN INDIVIDUAL BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY  
11 1, 1984, may operate a motorboat only if ~~he or she~~ THE INDIVIDUAL:

12 (a) Completes a boating safety course approved by the division of  
13 parks and wildlife OR COMPLETES A BOATING SAFETY COURSE IN ANOTHER  
14 JURISDICTION THAT MEETS THE COMMISSION'S REQUIREMENTS AS SET  
15 FORTH BY RULE; and

16 (b) (I) ~~Has POSSESSES~~ a boating safety certificate issued by the  
17 boating safety course provider. ~~in his or her possession.~~

18 (II) WHILE OPERATING A MOTORBOAT, AN INDIVIDUAL REQUIRED  
19 TO OBTAIN A BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO THIS  
20 SUBSECTION (2) SHALL KEEP THE BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE IN THE  
21 INDIVIDUAL'S IMMEDIATE POSSESSION OR IN AN ACCESSIBLE PLACE ON THE  
22 MOTORBOAT. A COURT MAY WAIVE FINES INCURRED BY AN INDIVIDUAL  
23 FOR NOT HAVING THE BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE IN THE INDIVIDUAL'S  
24 POSSESSION OR IN AN ACCESSIBLE PLACE AT THE TIME OF OPERATING A

1 MOTORBOAT IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS ABLE TO PRESENT EVIDENCE TO THE  
2 COURT OF HAVING COMPLETED A BOATING SAFETY COURSE PRIOR TO THE  
3 INFRACTION.

4 (3) ~~No person~~ AN INDIVIDUAL shall NOT permit or knowingly  
5 authorize a motorboat to be operated by a ~~person under sixteen years of~~  
6 age AN INDIVIDUAL BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1984; except that a  
7 person fourteen years of age or older who has not reached his or her  
8 sixteenth birthday AN INDIVIDUAL BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1984,  
9 may be permitted or authorized to operate a motorboat if he or she THE  
10 INDIVIDUAL has met the boating safety and certificate requirements of  
11 subsection (2) of this section.

12 (4) (a) ~~No owner or operator of a vessel livery or an agent or~~  
13 employee of such owner or operator shall lease, hire, or rent a motorboat  
14 to or for operation by any person under sixteen years of age; except that  
15 a person fourteen years of age or older who has not reached his or her  
16 sixteenth birthday may be permitted or authorized to operate a motorboat  
17 if he or she has met the boating safety and certificate requirements of  
18 subsection (2) of this section THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY TO  
19 ALL MOTORBOAT OPERATORS, INCLUDING OWNER-OPERATED  
20 MOTORBOATS, INDIVIDUALS OPERATING A MOTORBOAT WITH THE  
21 MOTORBOAT OWNER PRESENT, AND INDIVIDUALS RENTING A MOTORBOAT.

22 (b) THE COMMISSION MAY PROMULGATE RULES ESTABLISHING  
23 REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE RENTAL OF MOTORBOATS.

24 (5) Any ~~person~~ INDIVIDUAL who violates this section commits a  
25 civil infraction and, upon conviction, ~~thereof~~, shall be punished by a fine  
26 of one hundred dollars.

27 (6) It is the intent of the general assembly that ~~no~~ general fund

1 dollars SHALL NOT be appropriated for the purpose of implementing the  
2 requirements of this section.

3 **SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 33-13-107.2 as**  
4 follows:

5 **33-13-107.2. Motorboat operation rules. (1) ON OR BEFORE**  
6 **JULY 1, 2024, THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT RULES REGARDING THE**  
7 **REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS THAT A BOATING SAFETY COURSE**  
8 **MUST MEET FOR INDIVIDUALS TO BE AUTHORIZED TO OPERATE A**  
9 **MOTORBOAT IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 33-13-107.1.**

10 (2) THE COMMISSION MAY PROMULGATE RULES ESTABLISHING  
11 REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE RENTAL OF MOTORBOATS  
12 TO ENSURE THAT OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF RENTED MOTORBOATS MEET  
13 THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SECTION 33-13-107.1.

14 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. (1) Except**  
15 **as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this act takes effect upon**  
16 **passage; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section**  
17 **1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item,**  
18 **section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final**  
19 **adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item, section, or part**  
20 **will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election**  
21 **to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the**  
22 **date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.**

23 (2) Section 1 of the act takes effect on January 1, 2025.
