2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-514, **amend**
3 (4); and **repeal** (2) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-514. Evidence-based practices implementation for**
5 **capacity program - EPIC fund - creation - repeal.** (2) ~~(a) There is~~
6 ~~hereby created in the division the EPIC advisory board, referred to in this~~
7 ~~section as the "board".~~

8 ~~(b) The board shall exercise its powers and perform its duties and~~
9 ~~functions under the department of public safety.~~

10 ~~(c)(f) The board shall consist of, at a minimum, the following five~~
11 ~~members:~~

12 ~~(A) The executive director of the department of public safety or~~
13 ~~his or her designee;~~

14 ~~(B) The executive director of the department of corrections or his~~

26 repeal on September 1, 2023:

2 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
3 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
4 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
5 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
6 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
7 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
8 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
9 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
10 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
