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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A "BORN TO BE WILD" SPECIAL**  
102              **LICENSE PLATE TO RAISE FUNDS FOR NONLETHAL MEANS OF**  
103              **MITIGATING CONFLICT WITH GRAY WOLVES.**

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**Bill Summary**

*(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <http://leg.colorado.gov>.)*

The bill creates the "Born to Be Wild" special license plates for certain motorcycles, passenger cars, trucks, or noncommercial or recreational motor vehicles. An applicant qualifies for the issuance of the special license plates if the applicant pays all required taxes and fees. The department shall collect 3 separate fees as follows:

Shading denotes HOUSE amendment. Double underlining denotes SENATE amendment.  
*Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material to be added to existing law.  
Dashes through the words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law.*

- A one-time \$25 fee that is credited to the highway users tax fund;
- An annual \$50 fee that is credited to the wildlife cash fund in the division of parks and wildlife; and
- A one-time \$25 fee that is credited to the Colorado DRIVES vehicle services account.

The division of parks and wildlife is directed to use the money collected and credited to the wildlife cash fund for implementing nonlethal means of mitigating and preventing conflict with gray wolves.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** (1) The general assembly  
3 finds and declares that:

4           (a) The people of Colorado voted to restore gray wolves to the  
5 state;

6           (b) The deployment of programs, training, and equipment to  
7 support nonlethal means of reducing conflicts with gray wolves will  
8 protect the state's agricultural producers, sportspersons, and rural  
9 communities; and

10           (c) The "Born to Be Wild" license plate will generate significant  
11 funding to support the programs, training, and equipment needed to  
12 ensure the success of the gray wolf restoration program, mitigate and  
13 prevent conflicts with gray wolves, and support the will of Colorado  
14 citizens.

15           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 42-3-267 as  
16 follows:

17           **42-3-267. Special plates - Born to Be Wild - gray wolf conflict**  
18 **mitigation and prevention.** (1) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2024, OR  
19 WHEN THE DEPARTMENT IS ABLE TO ISSUE THE PLATES, THE DEPARTMENT  
20 SHALL ISSUE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS IN

1 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION FOR MOTORCYCLES, PASSENGER CARS,  
2 TRUCKS, OR NONCOMMERCIAL OR RECREATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLES THAT  
3 DO NOT EXCEED SIXTEEN THOUSAND POUNDS EMPTY WEIGHT.

4 (2) (a) THERE IS ESTABLISHED THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE  
5 PLATE.

6 (b) FOR THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATE ESTABLISHED  
7 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE A DESIGN  
8 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH DESIGN MUST CONFORM TO  
9 STANDARDS SET BY THE DEPARTMENT.

10 (3) A PERSON MAY APPLY FOR THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE  
11 PLATES IF THE PERSON PAYS THE TAXES AND FEES REQUIRED UNDER THIS  
12 SECTION.

13 (4) (a) THE AMOUNT OF TAXES AND FEES FOR SPECIAL LICENSE  
14 PLATES ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IS THE SAME AS THE AMOUNT  
15 OF THE TAXES AND FEES FOR REGULAR MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES;  
16 EXCEPT THAT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLECT THE FOLLOWING  
17 ADDITIONAL FEES:

18 (I) A ONE-TIME FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FOR THE ISSUANCE  
19 OR REPLACEMENT OF THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATES. THE  
20 DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT THE MONEY FROM THE FEE COLLECTED  
21 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (4)(a) TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO  
22 SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND CREATED IN  
23 SECTION 43-4-201.

24 (II) AN ANNUAL FIFTY DOLLAR FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OR  
25 REPLACEMENT OR CONTINUED USE OF THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE  
26 PLATES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT THE MONEY FROM THE FEE  
27 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (4)(b) TO THE STATE

1       TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND  
2       CREATED IN SECTION 33-1-112.

3               (III) A ONE-TIME SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE ISSUANCE FEE AS  
4       SPECIFIED IN SECTION 42-3-312.

5               (b) THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND WILDLIFE SHALL USE THE MONEY  
6       FROM FEES PAID PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4)(a) OF THIS SECTION FOR  
7       NONLETHAL METHODS OF MITIGATING AND PREVENTING CONFLICT WITH  
8       GRAY WOLVES AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 33-1-112 (1)(c).

9               (5) AN APPLICANT FOR THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATES  
10       MAY APPLY FOR PERSONALIZED "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATES.  
11       UPON PAYMENT OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211  
12       (6)(a) FOR PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE  
13       THE PLATES IF THE APPLICANT COMPLIES WITH SECTION 42-3-211. IF AN  
14       APPLICANT HAS EXISTING PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES FOR A MOTOR  
15       VEHICLE, THE APPLICANT MAY TRANSFER THE COMBINATION OF LETTERS  
16       OR NUMBERS TO A NEW SET OF "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATES FOR  
17       THE VEHICLE UPON PAYING THE FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 42-3-211 (6)(a)  
18       AND UPON TURNING IN THE EXISTING PLATES TO THE DEPARTMENT. A  
19       PERSON WHO HAS OBTAINED PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES UNDER THIS  
20       SUBSECTION (5) MUST PAY THE ANNUAL FEE IMPOSED BY SECTION  
21       42-3-211 (6)(b) TO RENEW THE PERSONALIZED PLATES. THE FEES UNDER  
22       THIS SUBSECTION (5) ARE IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER APPLICABLE TAXES  
23       AND FEES.

24               **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-1-112, **amend**  
25       (1)(a); and **add** (1)(c) as follows:

26               **33-1-112. Funds - cost accounting - definition - repeal.**  
27       (1) (a) Except as provided in subsections (7) and (8) of this section,

1 sections 33-1-112.5 and 33-6-105, and in part 7 of article 22 of title 39,  
2 ~~C.R.S.~~, all ~~moneys~~ MONEY received from wildlife license fees, and all  
3 ~~moneys~~ MONEY from all other wildlife sources, ALL MONEY FROM FEES  
4 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 42-3-267 (4)(a)(II), and all interest  
5 earned on such ~~moneys~~ MONEY shall be deposited in the state treasury and  
6 credited to the wildlife cash fund, which fund is hereby created. ~~and such~~  
7 ~~moneys~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1)(c) OF THIS SECTION, THE  
8 MONEY IN THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND shall be utilized for expenditures  
9 authorized or contemplated by and not inconsistent with the provisions of  
10 articles 1 to 6 of this ~~title~~ TITLE 33 for wildlife activities and functions and  
11 for the financing of impact assistance grants pursuant to part 3 of article  
12 25 of title 30. ~~C.R.S.~~ All ~~moneys~~ MONEY so deposited in the wildlife cash  
13 fund shall remain in ~~such~~ THE fund to be used for the purposes set forth  
14 in the provisions of articles 1 to 6 of this ~~title~~ TITLE 33 and shall not be  
15 deposited in or transferred to the general fund of the state of Colorado or  
16 any other fund.

17 (c) (I) THE DIVISION SHALL USE THE MONEY FROM FEES PAID  
18 PURSUANT TO SECTION 42-3-267 (4)(a)(II) AND DEPOSITED IN THE  
19 WILDLIFE CASH FUND FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES RELATED TO  
20 THE RESTORATION AND MANAGEMENT OF GRAY WOLVES PURSUANT TO  
21 SECTION 33-2-105.8:

22 (A) PROGRAMS, TRAINING, PERSONNEL, CONTRACTORS, AND  
23 COMMUNITY OUTREACH EVENTS RELATED TO NONLETHAL MEANS OF  
24 MITIGATING AND PREVENTING CONFLICT WITH GRAY WOLVES;

25 (B) THE PURCHASE AND DEPLOYMENT OF EQUIPMENT,  
26 TECHNOLOGY, AND TRAINING MATERIALS RELATED TO NONLETHAL MEANS  
27 OF MITIGATING AND PREVENTING CONFLICT WITH GRAY WOLVES;

1 (C) TO SUPPORT RESEARCH RELATED TO DEVELOPING MORE  
2 EFFECTIVE TOOLS, TECHNOLOGY, AND METHODS FOR MITIGATING AND  
3 PREVENTING CONFLICT WITH GRAY WOLVES BY NONLETHAL MEANS;

4 (D) TO SUPPORT THE OBSERVATION, MONITORING, AND  
5 NONLETHAL MANAGEMENT OF GRAY WOLF POPULATIONS;

6 (E) FOR PROMOTION OF THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATE,  
7 FOR WHICH THE DIVISION SHALL SOLICIT GRANT APPLICATIONS ANNUALLY  
8 FROM, AND MAY AWARD GRANTS TO, ORGANIZATIONS IN ORDER TO  
9 PROMOTE AND MARKET THE "BORN TO BE WILD" LICENSE PLATE; OR

10 (F) OTHER NONLETHAL MEANS FOR REDUCING CONFLICT WITH  
11 GRAY WOLVES, AS DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION.

12 (II) THE DIVISION SHALL NOT USE ANY MONEY FROM FEES PAID  
13 PURSUANT TO SECTION 42-3-267 (4)(a)(II) AND DEPOSITED IN THE  
14 WILDLIFE CASH FUND FOR THE LETHAL CONTROL OF WOLVES OR FOR  
15 COMPENSATION FOR WOLF DEPREDATION.

16 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-3-312 as  
17 follows:

18 **42-3-312. Special license plate surcharge.** In addition to any  
19 other fee imposed by this article 3, an applicant for a special license plate  
20 created by rule in accordance with section 42-3-207, as the section existed  
21 when the plate was created, or special license plates issued pursuant to  
22 sections 42-3-211 to 42-3-214, sections 42-3-217 to 42-3-218, sections  
23 42-3-221 to 42-3-234, sections 42-3-237 to 42-3-258, **and** sections  
24 42-3-260 to 42-3-265, AND SECTION 42-3-267 shall pay an issuance fee  
25 of twenty-five dollars; except that the fee is not imposed on special  
26 license plates exempted from additional fees for the issuance of a military  
27 special license plate by section 42-3-213 (1)(b)(II). The department shall

1 transfer the MONEY FROM THE fee to the state treasurer, who shall credit  
2 it to the Colorado DRIVES vehicle services account created in section  
3 42-1-211 (2).

4 **SECTION 5. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
5 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except  
7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V  
8 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this  
9 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take  
10 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
11 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
