#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision: (1) transfering any FY 2023-24 Long Bill appropriation for the Colorado Student Leaders Institute from the Department of Higher Education to the Department of Education; and (2) appropriating \$8,184 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2023-24. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Education will require an additional 0.1 FTE.
- **L.005** Bill Sponsor amendment **L.005** (attached) adds a statutory provision to allow: (1) up to 50 percent of the annual appropriation to the Department of Education, if unexpended at the end of a fiscal year, to roll forward for use in the next fiscal year; and (2) the FY 2022-23 appropriation to the Department of Higher Education to roll forward through FY 2023-24. The amendment also adds effective dates for provisions in the bill.

The Committee may adopt J.001 and L.005.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2023-24. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$8,184 for FY 2023-24, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2023-24 appropriations by this amount.
