The bill funds a supplemental payment of \$5 million to the Denver Health and Hospital Authority. It increases state expenditures in FY 2022-23 only.

Appropriation Summary: For FY 2023-24, the bill includes an appropriation of \$5 million to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill, which was recommended by the Joint Budget Committee as part of the FY 2022-23 supplemental budget package.

Summary of Legislation

The bill appropriates \$5 million from the General Fund to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) to distribute to the Denver Health and Hospital Authority.

State Expenditures

The bill increases state expenditures in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing by \$5 million in the current FY 2022-23 for distribution to the Denver Health and Hospital Authority for medical services.

Statutory Public Entity

The bill increases revenue to the Denver Health and Hospital Authority by the amount appropriated. Denver Health is the largest safety net health provider in the state. Per the department's budget request, this one-time supplemental payment will offset higher costs and lower-than-expected revenue experienced by Denver Health.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 3, 2023.

State Appropriations

For FY 2022-23, the bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$5,000,000 to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing.
