Summary of Legislation

The bill requires institutions of higher education that are not regionally accredited to provide all incoming students with an enrollment agreement or contract that outlines information regarding limited credit transferability. The document must include information about where students can obtain credit for prior learning, if applicable, and a statement that credits or credentials obtained at the school may not transfer to other colleges and that students should confirm whether an institution to which they plan to transfer will accept credits.

State Expenditures

The bill minimally increases workload for the Department of Higher Education to ensure compliance with the notice requirement. No change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 6, 2023, and takes effect August 7, 2023, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
