**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 24-006**

101 **CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF FEBRUARY 4 AS "MISSING**  
102 **PERSONS DAY" IN COLORADO.**

1 WHEREAS, Each year, hundreds of thousands of families are  
2 faced with what former President Ronald Reagan called "the stark terror  
3 of a unique tragedy" - a missing family member; and

4 WHEREAS, Every 40 seconds, someone goes missing in the  
5 United States; approximately 2,300 Americans are reported missing every  
6 day, and there are as many as 90,000 active missing persons cases in the  
7 United States at any given time; and

8 WHEREAS, As of December 31, 2023, the Federal Bureau of  
9 Investigation reported 96,955 active missing persons cases in the United  
10 States, with a large portion being juveniles under the age of 21; and

1           WHEREAS, Children and adults go missing for a number of  
2 reasons: They run away or wander and become lost; they disappear under  
3 circumstances indicating that their disappearance may not have been  
4 voluntary; or they go missing under suspicious circumstances, indicating  
5 that they may be in physical danger or the victims of foul play; and

6           WHEREAS, In 2002, then-Colorado Governor Bill Owens signed  
7 House Bill 02-1083, establishing the AMBER (America's Missing:  
8 Broadcast Emergency Response) Alert program in Colorado. Named after  
9 nine-year-old Amber Hagerman, who was abducted and killed in Texas  
10 in 1996, the program ensures that local law enforcement agencies can use  
11 Colorado's Emergency Alert System to broadcast information to alert  
12 citizens of missing children; and

13           WHEREAS, Since 1996, AMBER Alerts have successfully  
14 recovered 1,161 children; and

15           WHEREAS, According to the National Center for Missing and  
16 Exploited Children, 359,094 missing child reports were made to law  
17 enforcement in 2022. The organization currently lists 58 missing children  
18 from Colorado, from every area of the state. While all disappeared from  
19 their families when they were children, some have been missing for  
20 decades; and

21           WHEREAS, Too many families grieve, hope, and continue to  
22 search for missing family members of all ages; and

23           WHEREAS, The awareness, support, and efforts of citizens,  
24 media, and law enforcement related to the search for missing persons  
25 must continue; and

26           WHEREAS, The public plays a critical role in the success of the  
27 AMBER and other alert programs. As the eyes and ears of law  
28 enforcement, they can be on the lookout for missing persons; and

29           WHEREAS, The common misconception that a person must be  
30 absent for at least 24 hours before being legally classified as missing is  
31 dangerous; when there is evidence of violence or of an unusual absence,  
32 it is critical that an investigation begin promptly; and

33           WHEREAS, New advances in technology must be utilized and

1 made available to locate the missing; and

2 WHEREAS, The state of Colorado is committed to the safety and  
3 well-being of its citizens, both children and adults; and

4 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado  
5 firmly embeds the importance of missing persons and their families and  
6 friends in our state calendar and may help raise awareness in cities and  
7 states that have not designated a Missing Persons Day; and

8 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado  
9 offers a platform to plan events that will connect families with resources  
10 to help identify and find their missing loved ones; and

11 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado  
12 ensures that the families and friends of the missing know that they are not  
13 alone in their tragedy, uncertainty, and lack of closure, which lead to  
14 long-lasting suffering and impacts on the health, finances, and  
15 relationships of those left behind; and

16 WHEREAS, Every missing person is someone's child, parent,  
17 sibling, partner, or friend, and every missing person deserves to be  
18 searched for and found; now, therefore,

19 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-fourth General*  
20 *Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives*  
21 *concurring herein:*

22 (1) That we, the members of the General Assembly, recognize the  
23 epidemic of the missing in the United States as what the U.S. Department  
24 of Justice calls "The Silent Mass Disaster" and empathize with the  
25 ongoing suffering of the families and friends of those who are missing;

26 (2) That we recognize the importance of raising awareness of the  
27 number of people who go missing in Colorado each year;

28 (3) That we applaud the committed efforts of families, law  
29 enforcement agencies, and concerned citizens who work to locate missing  
30 persons;

31 (4) That we encourage continued support of initiatives and private  
32 and public programs to increase efforts to locate missing persons;

1 (5) That we hereby continue to designate February 4 of each year  
2 as Missing Persons Day and support the goals and ideals of the day; and

3 (6) That we acknowledge the names and the families of the
