In the current fiscal year, the bill transfers \$2.5 million from the General Fund to the Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires a transfer of \$2.5 million from the General Fund to the Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund in the Judicial Department on April 1, 2024.

Background

The Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund receives revenue from alternative fees paid by criminal defendants who cannot pay assessed fees, fines, or penalties. Annual appropriations from the fund support the Collection Investigator Program in the Judicial Department.

State Transfers

In the current FY 2023-24 only, the bill transfers \$2.5 million from the General Fund to the Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund in the Judicial Department.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on February 27, 2024.
