Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$291,711 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2024-25. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.2 FTE.

L.012, L.014 and J.002

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.012** (attached) moves the date by which the Department of Education must contract to establish a statewide hotline for justice-engaged students from September 1, 2025 to September 1, 2026 and specifies the date on which the Department must provide a support person position to assist justice-involved students from rural and small frontier districts to July 1, 2025. It also adds language requiring courts to take into consideration a juvenile's educational progress when establishing conditions of release and detention.

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.014** (attached) moves the date by which the Department of Education must partner to develop a training program related to the justice-engaged student's bill of rights and make the training available to local education providers from August 1, 2025 to August 1, 2026. It also clarifies that the State Board of Education shall promulgate rules *beginning* July 1, 2025.

If these amendments are adopted, LCS and JBC Staff concur that the fiscal impact of this bill will be as shown in the table below.

Bill Sponsor amendment **J.002** (attached) provides an FY 2024-25 appropriation of \$82,883 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2024-25, consistent with adoption of **L.012** and **L.014**.

The Committee may adopt J.001 OR the combination of L.012, L.014, and J.002.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$291,711 (if **J.001** is adopted) or \$85,334 (if **L.012**, **L.014**, and **J.002** are adopted) for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$63.1 million set aside by the same amount.
