Bill Topic:	DESIGNATION OF HIGHWAY ZONES
Summary of Fiscal Impact:	<b>No fiscal impact.</b> The bill modifies rules for designating portions of state highway as a maintenance, repair, or construction zone. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.
Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

### **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (CDOT) may designate a portion of a highway as a highway maintenance, repair, or construction zone if maintenance, repair, or construction activities are occurring or will occur within four hours. The bill removes the four-hour time period and requires CDOT to designate that portion of state highway as a highway construction zone when construction is on a state highway.

### **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill modifies rules related to how CDOT may designate maintenance, repair, or construction zones on state highways. CDOT currently designates zones for areas of highways with construction, repair, or maintenance activities, and the bill will not have an impact on this procedure. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
