Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision providing \$309,195 to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2024-25, including \$154,598 cash funds from the Healthcare Affordability and Sustainability Fee and \$154,597 matching federal Medicaid funds. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 3.4 FTE.

Points to Consider

Future Fiscal Impact

The cost to implement the bill increases from \$376,588 in FY 2024-25 to \$1.6 million in FY 2025-26 and \$9.5 million total funds, including just under \$1.0 million General Fund (including the reserve impact), in FY 2026-27 and thereafter.
