Article 12—Cemeteries

OLLS noted that Article 12 is a candidate for relocation, but there is no obvious spot for it. Possible places for it to be relocated are Title 6, as there are consumer protection elements; Title 38, because it relates to real property; or maybe Title 15, which was suggested by the Department of Law at a prior meeting.

Article 44—Hotel Establishments

OLLS noted that Article 44 is a candidate for relocation, but again, it is unclear where it should go. We are considering Title 6, although the Department of Law expressed concern at a prior meeting about whether this was a good fit; Title 38, as the relationship between an innkeeper and guest is similar to landlords and tenants, which are located in Article 12 of that title; or given the liability component, maybe Title 13.

Article 37.5—Parental Abortion Notification

OLLS suggested moving the article as a new part to Article 22 of Title 13, age of competence – arbitration – mediation. OLLS noted that the article was an initiative, so there may be a desire to keep it in Title 12, since the voters placed it there.
